Aim:

Provide practice principles, knowledge and skills to identify and respond to the needs of infants, children and young people affected by family and domestic violence, using a Western Australian intervention practice framework.

Target group:

All professionals, who may not be specialised family violence workers, directly engaging and supporting infants, children, young people and families who may be affected by family violence.

Learning Outcomes

1. Interact with children using a recognised trauma-informed practice early intervention framework.
2. Explore trauma and attachment impacts of family violence.
3. Apply practice principles to identify the needs of children and risk and threats to safety.
